KINGSWOOD SUBDIVISION (9.815 acres being out of lot 17, Cunningham's Subdivision) – Development is located at the south side of Primera Road, west of the intersection of Primera Road and the Southbound Frontage Road of Expressway 77, within the City of Harlingen. Motion was made by Nicholas Consiglio, seconded by Jerome Wade to deny this plat due to lack of and incorrect information. Following a discussion, the motion passed.

CORSIF ACRES SUBDIVISION (Being 3.73 acres of land out of Block Number Two (2), F.Z. Bishop Subdivision of Section No. 39) – Potable water will be provided by the Harlingen Water Works and sanitary sewer will be by an on site system. A license agreement has been signed. Motion was made by Jerome Wade, seconded by Nicholas Consiglio to approve and sign this subdivision plat. Following a discussion, the motion passed.
